**Description:** Anti-PIK3CA (Q546P) Mouse Monoclonal Antibody

**Background:** Phosphatidyl 3-kinases (PI3K) are a family of lipid kinases involved in many cellular processes, including cell growth, proliferation, differentiation, motility, and survival. It is composed of an 85 kDa regulatory subunit and a 110 kDa catalytic subunit. Mutants of PIK3CA has been found in the pathogenesis of several cancers, including colon cancer, gliomas, gastric cancer, breast cancer, endometrial cancer, and lung cancer.

**Immunogen:** A synthetic peptide from the internal region of PIK3CA which includes the mutation of Q546P, human origin.

**Tested applications:** ELISA, WB


Preservative: no

Constituents: PBS (without Mg<sup>2+</sup> and Ca<sup>2+</sup>), pH 7.4, 150 mM NaCl, 50% glycerol

**Species Reactivity:** Recognizes Q546P mutant, but not wild-type PIK3CA of vertebrates.

**Storage Conditions:** Store at -20°C. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.

**Western blot analysis of recombinant PIK3CA (Q546P) and wildtype proteins.** Purified His-tagged PIK3CA (Q546P) protein (lane 2) and corresponding wildtype protein (lane 1) were blotted with anti-PIK3CA (Q546P) monoclonal antibody (Cat. #26213).
